Our procedure will be as follows:

Step 1 - Register for the "Company Results Presentations Package" [HERE](#).

Only paid-up members will have access the e-learning platform (YOUR CPD HUB).

Step 2 – After receiving an email to activate your profile on YOUR CPD HUB, you will be able to watch a recording of the presentations, complete the online assessments (5 questions) and get their PDF certificate.

Access is exclusively via the IASSA CPD HUB's "Company Results Presentations" package [HERE](#).

Step 3 – PDF certificates will be available to download immediately after passing the assessment and stored in your user profile on YOUR CPD HUB.

Due to time constraints and confidentiality the questions and recording will only be available on YOUR CPD HUB (e-learning platform) 48 hours after the actual presentation.

We have partnered with BLACK ONYX who will be able to offer members further educational opportunities for CPD, issue certificates and keep a record of your credits received via the [IASSA CPD HUB](#).

We emphasise that there will be *no live* sign in and sign out at the event (except on rare occasions) and whether you attended live, or viewed the webcast, you will be required to view the questions on the BLACK ONYX / IASSA CPD HUB.
